- Paul Lyons' brother, Donald, was admitted to Piedmont Newnan Wednesday night with a blood clot in his lung.

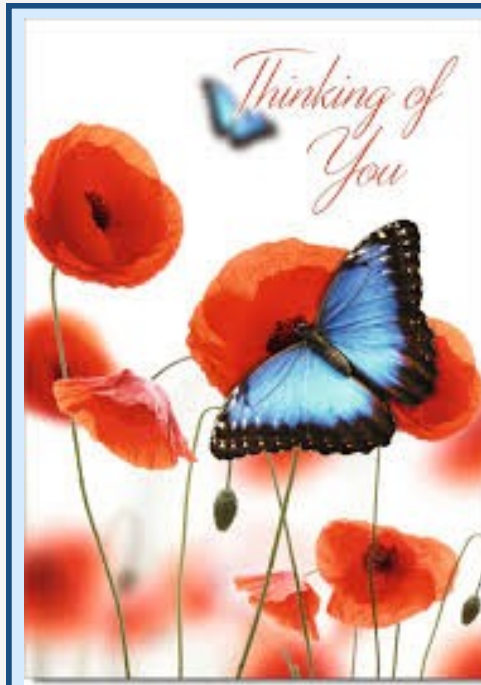

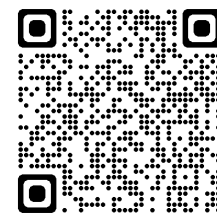
